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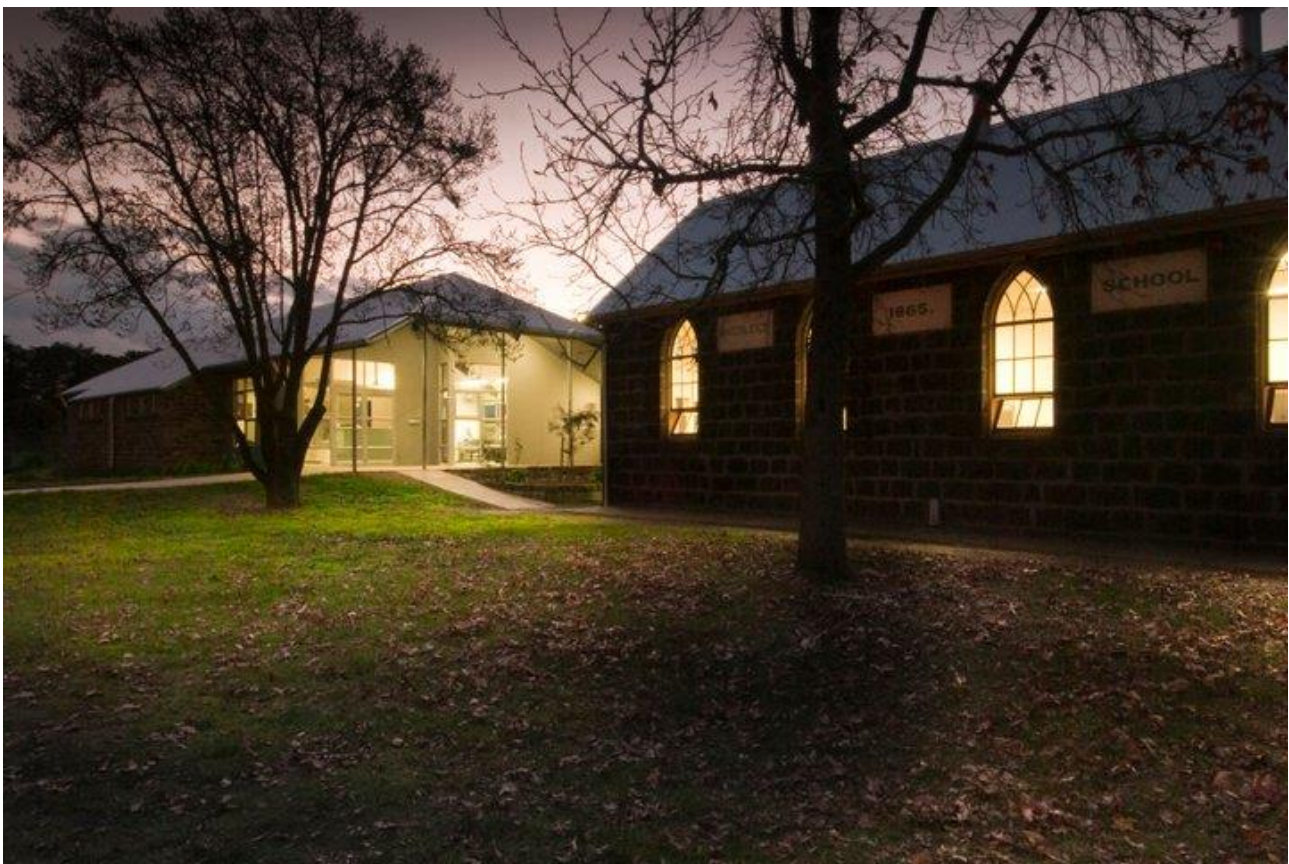

Hello everyone,

Firstly, thank you for the way you have adapted back into Remote Learning. I know that this can be a challenging time, especially if you are juggling your own work commitments along with supporting your student's learning from home. Teachers always try to plan activities that will continue the learning of our students without placing too much additional pressure on families. Our priority is to continue the learning of each child and help them to stay connected to their learning, to their teachers and to their peers. It has been wonderful seeing so many happy faces at the morning Google Meets! I'm sure that you are all aware of the news that was announced this morning - the current lockdown will be extended for a further 5 school days. Knowing this, we will be making some slight changes to our day to provide further structure and support – classroom teachers will be communicating this information at the whole class 'Meets' tomorrow.

There has been an increasing number of inquiries about students attending on-site. Please note that students must meet the eligibility criteria below in order to be able to attend on-site.

1. All students will be learning from home from 16 – 27 July, except for students in the following categories:

- Children where both parents and or carers are considered [authorised workers](#) who cannot work from home, work for an essential provider **and where no other supervision arrangements can be made:**
 - Where there are two parents/carers, both must be essential workers, working outside the home in order for their children to be eligible for on-site provision.
 - For single parents/ carers, the essential worker must be working outside the home in order for their children to be eligible for on-site provision.
- Children experiencing vulnerability, including:
 - children in out-of-home care
 - children deemed vulnerable by a government agency, funded family or family violence service, and assessed as requiring education and care outside the family home
 - children identified by a school or early childhood service as vulnerable, (including via referral from a government agency, or funded family or family violence service, homeless or youth justice service or mental health or other health service)

Today a third category was added. If your child has a disability and they cannot learn from home, they will be eligible to attend on-site.

From tomorrow, Wednesday July 21, if you meet the eligibility criteria and you need your child to attend on-site, you must complete the On-Site Attendance form (blue). The form is attached to this newsletter, and can also be found on Sentral, under Forms. Please download the form, complete it and email it to sharon.baker2@education.vic.gov.au

2022 ENROLMENTS

It is that time of year again where we ask parents to enrol their children for 2022. As we are increasingly getting enrolments from outside as people are building etc. it is becoming important for our planning to know who will be here next year. CSEF- CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS

If you (the parent) **hold a valid means-tested concession card** or temporary foster parents may be eligible for CSEF – Camps, Sports & Excursion Fund.

Please attend the office with your **current Concession Card** and complete the CSEF form. \$125.00 will be paid for eligible primary school students. Payments will go directly to the school and be tied to the student. This money can be used towards camps, sports, and excursions – **it is NOT able to be used towards fees or uniform.**

BEFORE SCHOOL CARE

The Before School Care Program will continue throughout Term 3. In order for Inverleigh to continue having a Before School Care Program throughout the year the number of students attending each morning will need to increase so please utilise the program.


Scholastic Book Club

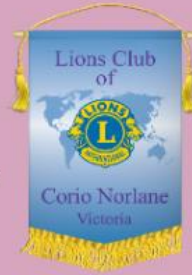
